




# **Concurrent Monitoring of RISE Scale up**



About 9800+ learners, 11 districts from Odisha, 11 districts from MP and 08 from HP have been accessing the course




Learners earned more Gold certificate in Module 4 followed by Module 5

### "RISE- The protagonist of e-learning"

I am involved in RISE training package from the beginning, that is, from the creation of vaccinators database at the block level till the completion of all 5 modules of RISE in our block recently. All the 41 learners from our block have completed all the five modules, out of which 71% have earned gold certificates. I track the progress of the learners towards completion whenever any module was made golive. I also did handholding of the learners who were finding little difficulty to complete the modules. I called them to the office, particularly the elderly learners, for whom taking the course on mobile app was difficult. I tried to troubleshoot their problems at my end and whenever required took the help of state RISE team. Vaccinators know about their immunization work, but this app is very useful for workers because it has improved their knowledge and skill in the field such as site of vaccine administration and doses of vaccines, practice of using the hub-cutter, segregation of BMW etc. The app is featured with audio-visual content and filled with interactions like games and quizzes. Due to the flexibility feature, the workers can use the app anywhere at his/her own comfort. Since, it is a self-learning app, it is helpful in refreshing the knowledge. The certificate earned after attempting post assessment gives a feel of examination and learners gets excited to see their certificates. I always remind them to complete the app with proper understanding of the content which is developed for them only.

RISE dashboard is also very easy to navigate and user friendly in preparing various reports for the program. It helps the officers to monitor training activities very comfortably. At last, I feel that various other public health programs should also be developed in RISE pattern which will help to improve the knowledge of the learners and in clarifying the doubts precisely.

# **RISE Pilot Phase- A Glimpse**

RISE was implemented during March-August 2020 as a pilot project in five states of India (Himachal Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Odisha, and Tamil Nadu) for capacity building of 2600+ health workers. It was rolled out to address the growing needs of the large number of healthcare workers due to rapid development in India's immunization program.

It was very well accepted by the learners. 100 % course completion was achieved in Madhya Pradesh and Himachal Pradesh, while it was 96% in Odisha and 74% and 68% in Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra respectively.

The pilot phase generated evidence of positive outcomes in establishing the effectiveness of this training model. A definite increase (14%) in knowledge levels of the learners who completed the course, was observed during endline assessment as compared to baseline values. More than 65% of the learners achieved gold certificate (score more than 85 out of 100) while 34% received silver certificate (score between 70-85 out of 100).

The improved knowledge also got translated in improving the practices of health workers during the immunization sessions, as observed during the practice assessment.
