




RISE Refresher in Pilot Districts

Khordha, Odisha




- ✓ About 384 learners from Khordha district have been accessing the RISE training Course as a *Refresher Training*.
- ✓ More than 75 % of the learners out of the total learners (384) have completed the Module 1 as on 31st May 2022.
- ✓ About 59 % of the learners out of the total learners (384) have completed all the Modules as on 31st May 2022

Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh




- ✓ About 262 learners from Bhopal district have been accessing the RISE training course as a *Refresher Training*.
- ✓ In Bhopal, Module 1 has been rolled out on 21st May 2022 and Module 2 was rolled out on 29th May 2022.
- ✓ About 41 % of the learners out of the total learners (262) have started the Module 1 as on 31st May 2022.
- ✓ About 26 % of the learners have completed the Module 1 while 15 % have completed Module 2 out of the total district's learners (262) as on 31st May 2022.


Concurrent Monitoring of RISE Scale up

Stories from the field

Mr. Surya Kanta Sahoo Block Data Manager (BDM), CHC Subarnapur Block- Banki, District-Cuttack, Odisha



It was 20th December 2021. That day, I first came to know about this beautiful and easy mode of training, i.e., RISE. My work started with creating updated database of vaccinators and recently finished with all 20 vaccinators of my block completed the training through RISE app. The old age of vaccinators and unstable internet connection had created some hurdles in the training but the determination of marching forward made the orientation training successful on 21/02/2022. On 30th March 2022, the first module of RISE was live for Cuttack district. As this was a new concept. it took little bit more time for them. Those vaccinators who were of old age were called to the CHC and were given hand holding support. I was regularly following up with each and every person who had not completed the process within a day or two. I also took the help of our superintendent, who regularly monitored the process. The vaccinators also enjoyed and learned a lot in the process. The pre-test and post-test questionnaires and also the quizzes helped them to participate deeply and heartily.

I think that RISE is a very easy way to train health workers and other cadres in several other public health programs.

When RISE program started for the first time, I had many apprehensions about this online training. Being at the faroff block of the district, I was not sure of its successful implementation. But, when it was piloted in 2020, Bolagarh block could complete all the modules of RISE in stipulated time. It was again implemented after a year or so in 2022 and I was confident about the success of the program. But, this time due to vacancy of BDM position in Begunia Block (adjacent to Bolagarh), the district authority gave me the additional charge of that block. It was really a challenge for me to complete both blocks training in time. But as the saying goes, nothing is impossible if you have the courage to face it, 48 health workers of both Bolagarh and Begunia block completed all the 5 modules again and benefitted by enhancing their immunization skill through RISE. Both the blocks have pioneered in the district in completing the RISE modules. This has happened due to continuous monitoring, follow-up and handholding support to the health workers.

RISE was implemented during March- August 2020 as a pilot project in five states of India (Himachal Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Odisha, and Tamil Nadu) for capacity building of 2600+ health workers. It was rolled out to address the growing needs of the large number of healthcare workers due to rapid development in India's immunization program.

It was very well accepted by the learners. 100 % course completion was achieved in Madhya Pradesh and Himachal Pradesh, while it was 96% in Odisha and 74% and 68% in Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra respectively. The pilot phase generated evidence of positive outcomes in establishing the effectiveness of this training model. A definite increase (14%) in knowledge levels of the learners who completed the course, was observed during endline assessment as compared to baseline values. More than 65% of the learners achieved gold certificate (score more than 85 out of 100) while 34% received silver certificate (score between 70-85 out of 100).

The improved knowledge also got translated in improving the practices of health workers during the immunization sessions, as observed during the practice assessment.
