

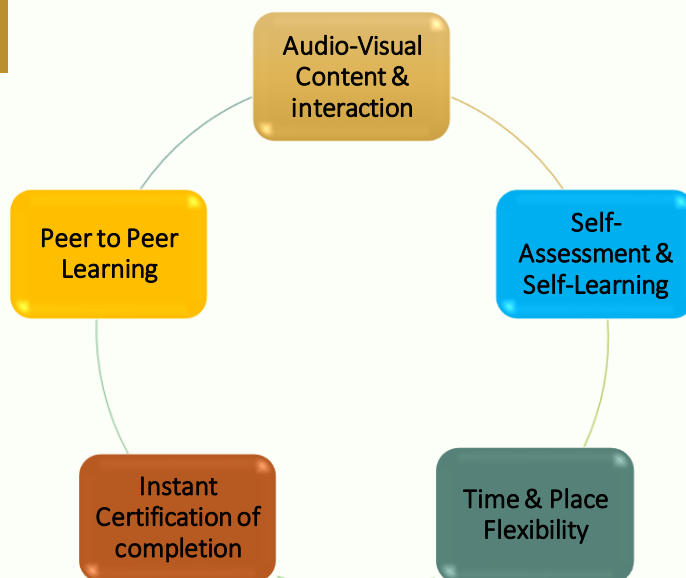

- *Interactive digital self-learning*

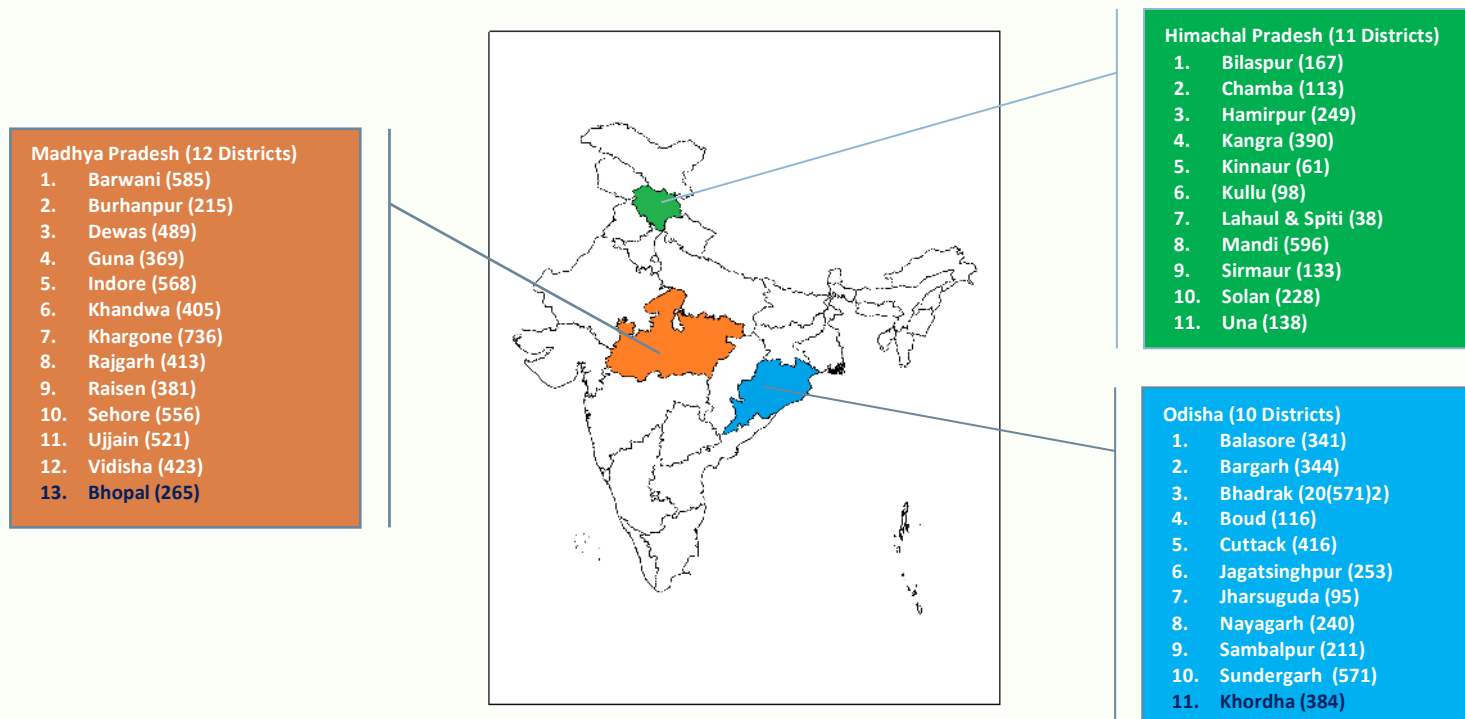

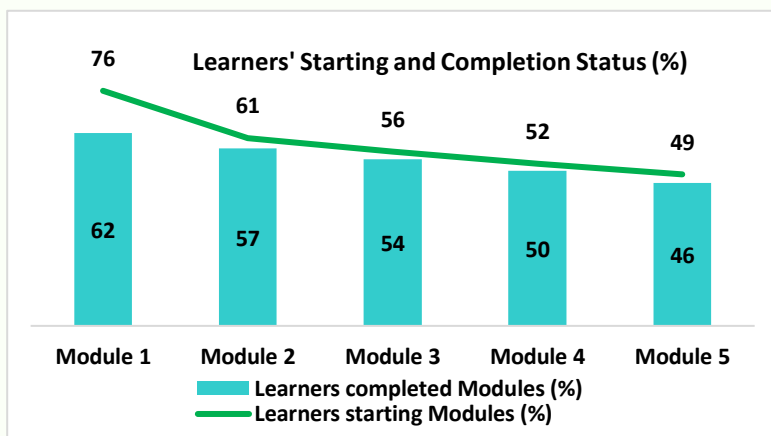

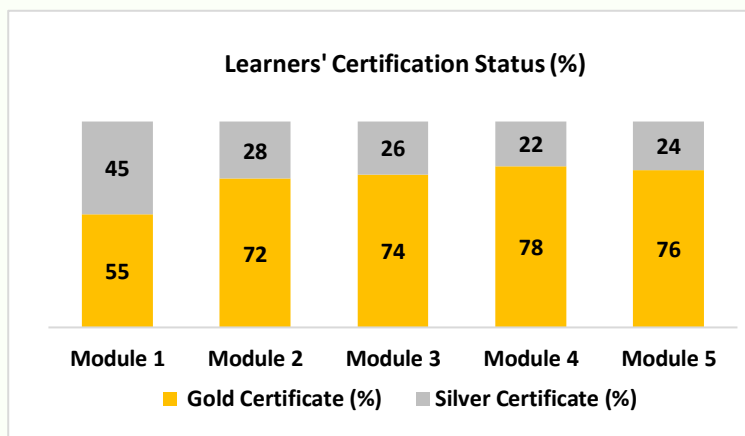

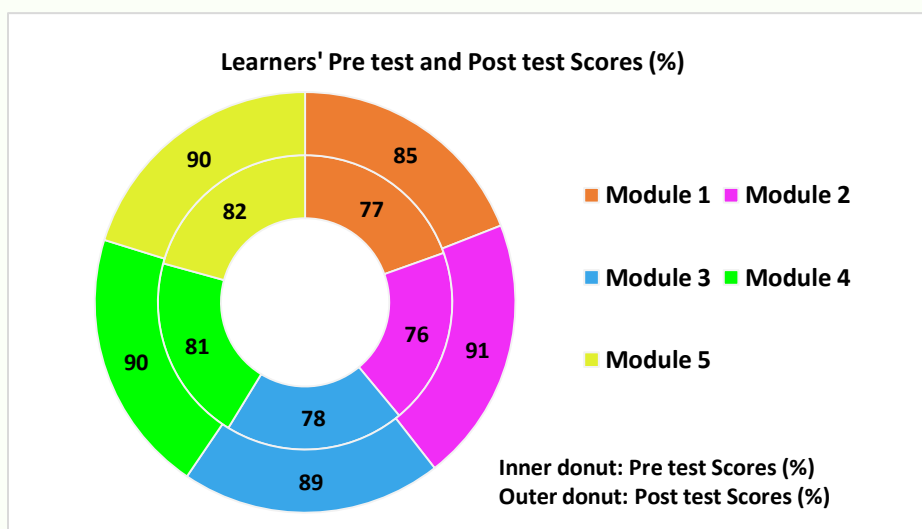
Concurrent Monitoring of RISE Scale up



About 10800+ learners in 32 districts have been accessing the course



Highest percentage of Gold certificate is in Module 4, followed by Module 5



- On an average 10 points increase in knowledge levels is observed among the learners
- Highest knowledge gain (14 points) is observed in Module 2, followed by Module 3 (11 points)

Rapid Immunization Skill Enhancement (RISE) is a very useful and innovative application to all health workers including Community Health Officers (CHOs). Health workers are gaining the knowledge through RISE training, as a result we are rapidly able to provide better immunization services and effective communication with the community. Health workers are enhancing their working skills by watching videos. I think this is an important and very easy application, however some workers could not complete & left the training in between, because of experiencing many technical problems while using the RISE application. We are providing our support to these workers during sector meetings and making them enable to complete the modules once go live in the district.

Peer to peer learning is a good way and CHOs may play an important role in troubleshooting but to increase the CHOs interest, their role in immunization program may also be highlighted in animated videos.

RISE Pilot Project- A Glimpse

RISE was implemented during March- August 2020 as a pilot project in five states of India (Himachal Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Odisha, and Tamil Nadu) for capacity building of 2600+ health workers. It was rolled out to address the growing needs of the large number of healthcare workers due to rapid development in India's immunization program.

It was very well accepted by the learners. 100 % course completion was achieved in Madhya Pradesh and Himachal Pradesh, while it was 96% in Odisha and 74% and 68% in Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra respectively.

The pilot phase generated evidence of positive outcomes in establishing the effectiveness of this training model. A definite increase (14%) in knowledge levels of the learners who completed the course, was observed during endline assessment as compared to baseline values. More than 65% of the learners achieved gold certificate (score more than 85 out of 100) while 34% received silver certificate (score between 70-85 out of 100).

The improved knowledge also got translated in improving the practices of health workers during the immunization sessions, as observed during the practice assessment.
